


28" MEMORY BEAR

Sewing Directions and Video

Cut out all pieces of Memory Bear pattern from two shirts:




Shirt




Contrast Shirt

1 Sew **Head Sides**, right sides together, along center front seam, matching notches.




2 Sew **Head Center** to **Head Sides** matching notches.




3 Attach eyes at X on **Head Center**.




4 Sew **Ears**, right sides together, leaving straight edge open. Clip curves, and turn right side out. Stuff the **Ears** with Poly-fil. Pin **Ears** to **Center Head** seams, baste.




5 Sew **Head Back** right sides together along the center back seam.



6. Sew **Head Back** to the **Head Center and Head Sides**, right sides together, leaving the neck edge open. Clip curves, and turn right sides out.




7. Sew the **Body Front** right sides together at the center front seam.



8. Sew the **Legs**, right sides together at front seams. Clip curves.


9. Sew the **Leg** back seams, right sides together above and below notches, leaving an opening between the notches.




10. Sew the **Foot Pad** to the bottom of the **Leg**.



11. Turn **Legs** right side out. Fold the top of each **Leg**, bringing the front and the back seams together. Baste.




12. Pin the top of the front seam of **Leg** to right side of **Body Front**. Baste.



13. Sew the **Body Back**, right sides together, along the center back seam. Sew above and below notches, leaving an opening between notches.




14. Sew the **Body Back** to the **Body Front** matching the center seams, and leaving the neck open. **Legs** should be folded to the inside.




15. Turn the bear right side out through the neck opening.


16. Sew the **Paw Pad** to **Inner Arm** right sides together,




17. Sew *Paw Pad and Inner Arm*, to *Outer Arm*, right sides together, above and below notches, leaving an opening between notches.



18. Turn arms right side out. Pin arms to the body at neck edge, centering over side seams of body. Baste.



19. Turn the bear body wrong side out. Put the bear head, right side out, inside the bear body matching center back seams of head and body. Pin head to body, right sides together at neck edge. Sew.



20. Turn bear right side out through *Body Back* center seam. Stuff all parts of the bear with Poly-fil, and hand stitch openings.
